As a registered player of the Dingley Junior Football Club, I agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct and Behaviour policy.

- To play by the rules.
- Never argue with an umpire or official. If there is a disagreement, I will speak to my captain, coach or team manager about the issue.
- Control my temper. I understand that verbal abuse of officials and sledging of other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable behaviour.
- Work equally hard for myself and my team.
- Be a good sport & applaud all good plays.
- To treat all participants as I would like to be treated & not to bully or take unfair advantage over another competitor or team mate
- To cooperate with my coach, team manager, teammates and opponents as without them there would be no competition.
- To participate for my own enjoyment, not just to please parents & coaches.
- To respect the rights, dignity & worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

I understand that this code of conduct and behaviour policy applies not only during matches, but also at training and whenever I am representing the Dingley Junior Football Club, for example Match Report nights, away game venues, spectating at matches of other age groups etc.
